To attend our first NYLT:

- Scouts must be 13, but not yet 18; Venturers must not yet be 21.
- Boy Scouts must be at least a First Class Scout and have completed Introduction to Leadership Skills for Troops.
- Venturers must have completed Crew Officer Orientation and Introduction to Leadership Skills for Crews.
- Be recommended and approved by your Scoutmaster/Crew Advisor.
- Pay the course fee of \$200. A \$50 deposit will your secure your spot, but all fees due by 6/1/2012

Our NYLT course will be limited to 48 Scouts/Venturers. The Council reserves the right to limit the number of participants from the same Unit in order to enable as many troops/crews as possible to train their leaders.
