Contingent Fees Policy for the Suwannee River Area Council ("SRAC") 2010 BSA National Jamboree

Each Confirmation Application submitted to the SRAC Council Service Center must be accompanied by a \$100 deposit, this agreement, and the Code of Conduct.

Priority of Troop assignments will be based on the date the National Application is made on-line. The Confirmation- Application and deposit submission to the Service Center will be our way of knowing who has applied and when. So when the scouts information gets to the Service Center is not quite as important as when the scout applies on-line! Remember there are only 72 scout spots to be filled, after that a waiting list will be formed. A lot can happen between now and then so some flexibility is needed.

So let everyone agree on these rules:

Refund Policy:

The following is a schedule of dates for refunds of deposits and fees if you are unable to go.

Money paid toward the Jamboree contingent fee at the Scout Service Center are refundable except as noted in the schedule below.

These dates and amounts are based on commitments made on your behalf for such things as Jamboree registration to BSA National, Travel arrangements, tours, buses, hotels, patches, troop equipment.

If a scout is not accepted into the contingent, funds will be returned, less the \$10 fee incurred during the on-line BSA National registration.

August 1, 2008.	\$100	Deposit becomes non-refundable after this date.
January 1, 2009.	\$500	Portion of funds paid become non-refundable after this date.
September 1, 2009.	\$1,000	Portion of funds paid become non-refundable after this date.
April 1, 2010.	\$2,350	Balance of funds paid become non-refundable after this date.

****Note*****

If for some reason you are not able to go, we have a way to save you some money!! You will receive a full refund, less the \$100 deposit, if you recruit a Scout, or someone from the waiting list signs up and that Scout registers before June 1, 2010. The new Scout must bring the Jamboree contingent fee up to date in full, then upon approval by the SRAC Jamboree Budget Committee you will be refunded.

Keep in mind that funds expended for you may not be recoverable and therefore may not be refunded.

If after acceptance into the contingent a scout is no longer eligible to attend with the SRAC Jamboree contingent due to his lack of compliance with the Jamboree Code of Conduct refunds will be made based on the above schedule.
