

What is Cope?

Challenging Outdoor personal Experience consists of group initiatives, a low challenge course, and a high challenge course that bring your group face-to-face with a series of problem solving activities requiring cooperation. Your group may have to, climb a wall, or move through a gigantic spider's web. While no special physical skills are needed to participate, some physical effort is required for most tasks, but the real challenge lies in communicating with fellow participants to figure out a solution and then actively solving the problem.

The **Cope Course** at Camp Wallwood is a great teambuilding activity and a must for any group seeking its dynamics and cohesiveness. Your session at Camp Wallwood is tailored to focus on your group's specific goals in an atmosphere where participants are encouraged to meet challenges through group support and voluntary participation. Located just off Lake Talquin in Gadsden Co, The Cope Course is an outdoor adventure your group should not miss! Don't be fooled by what, at first glance, appears to be an easy course simply because it may be low to the ground. There are formidable challenges to be confronted that require collaboration to solve.
