What is the Boy Scout Golden Eagle Event?

The Golden Eagle Dinner is the single largest annual fundraising event that fuels the Scouting program in Leon County. It brings together business, civic and political leaders of our community to share Scouting's impact on youth. It also affords Scouting the opportunity to honor great community leaders for their service. This year's Honorees are Charlie & Tonja Ward and Ash & Jan Williams.

Who's going to attend the Golden Eagle Event?

Last year, more than 350 community leaders attended the Golden Eagle Dinner. The effort is led and organized by a team of volunteers. This team helps identify and recruit corporate sponsors, volunteers, attendees and donors. The co-chairs for the 2024 dinner are Peter & Jennifer Collins and Lawton & Beth Langford.

How much does it cost to attend the Golden Eagle Event?

There is no ticket cost to attend the Golden Eagle Dinner. All attendees will be asked to consider a pledge based on their history of giving. If they have no history, the amount requested is \$250 per person. Pledges can be paid at once, semi-annually, monthly or quarterly.

What's the goal?

The goal of the 2024 Boy Scout Golden Eagle Dinner is to raise \$250,000 for Scouting. The Suwannee River Area Council serves 13 counties, including Leon, Gadsden, Wakulla, Liberty, Franklin, Jefferson, Madison, Taylor, Seminole, Decatur, Grady, Thomas, and Colquitt.

What does the fundraising accomplish?

Scouting serves nearly 1,400 youth throughout our area, as well as over 500 registered volunteers. Since our last Golden Eagle Dinner, 30 young men & women earned the rank of Eagle Scout, and over 19,000 pounds of food was collected during our Scouting for Food drive.
